TEXTBOOKS FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSES

In July 2009, the State Board of Education (SBOE) adopted newly revised Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for career and technical education (CTE). The new TEKS reduce the number of courses from 607 to 194, update technical and academic content, increase rigor and relevance, imbed college and career readiness standards, and align with the nationally recognized 16 career clusters. Districts must implement these new courses with the 2010-2011 school year.

Since new instructional material for the CTE courses will not be available to districts for several years, the Texas Education Agency is allowing districts to request CTE materials that were adopted in 2003 under Proclamation 2001 that correspond to the new courses. Conversation with TEA

- These materials were reviewed by a state review panel in February, are scheduled for adoption in April, and are scheduled to be available for use in schools beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.
- Currently midcycle materials can only be obtained by districts using textbook credits. Legislative action can, of course, change that current requirement.
- The only publisher whose materials are under consideration for adoption is CEV.

Reporting District Population

Collect the data you need:

- ❑ Your CATE coordinator should have information relating your district courses to the information in the TEA "Crosswalk".
- ❑ Get a copy of the TEA "Crosswalk"

- ❑ Get your district state charge list showing the CATE textbooks your district currently has.
- ❑ Your student populations for the courses from your PEIMS Coordinator.

Analyze the Data – Make the Decision

- ❑ Look at the textbooks that are now associated with the new course. Your CATE Coordinator/teachers must pick 1 title per course. Post the other titles as surplus.
- ❑ Compare student numbers to see if you have surplus copies of the textbook your district picked.
- ❑ If you use CEV's curriculum caddies for any of these courses, you cannot return them, so if you have a new course that merged two old courses ... one using a caddy and one using a textbook, you would HAVE to return the textbook to reduce your surplus.
- ❑ Don't order any more CATE textbooks until you understand the new rules ...
